



Fact Sheet

Volunteers in Medicine (VIM) is the only national nonprofit dedicated to the development of a network of free clinics based on the VIM model, which emphasizes the use of retired health care professionals and community volunteers to care for America's uninsured. VIM's mission is to promote and guide the development of a national network of free clinics using these dedicated volunteers to address the needs of this underserved population.

All VIM clinics provide general primary care and patient education programs. Specialized services range from pediatrics and dentistry to ophthalmology and counseling. Diabetes, hypertension, asthma, acute respiratory infection, depression and anxiety are the diseases most frequently treated in VIM clinics.

In 2010, over 100,000 patients made more than 350,000 visits to the then 82 VIM clinics. Nearly 11,000 medical and non-medical volunteers shared their time and skills in the VIM network.

Volunteers in Medicine is collaborating with the American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) Foundation to promote *Family Medicine Cares*, the Foundation's new humanitarian program established to assist free clinics in caring for the uninsured. VIM is also partnering with AARP and the National Council of Churches Health Care Task Force to build awareness and further the mutual missions of each organization. McNeil Consumer & Specialty Pharmaceuticals, makers of Tylenol®, has been the sustaining financial source for the VIM national office.
